A Turkish tone poem, an exploration of the country's many connections with water—spiritual, cultural, environmental—and a journey from urban streets to the deep caves of Antalya.

Through the pen and paint of artist Margaret Tolbert and the lens of filmmaker Daghan Celayir, "Su" paints a picture of a country's ancient and unique relationship with its water.

The journey culminates with an exploratory dive into the mysterious underwater caves of Kirkgoz springs and Burdur Insuyu cave system, pushing deep underground for a glimpse at Turkey's watery heart.
